VENICE CEMETERY AND COLUMBARIUM RULES AND REGULATIONS

To maintain the beauty of the Cemetery, the following rules will be enforced:

1. The cemetery is open from dawn to dusk.
2. Children are allowed with adult supervision only.
3. Pets are permitted but must always be on a leash. Pet owners must clean up after their pet/s.
4. Graves must remain free from shepherd hooks, flag stands/holders, food items, boxes, shells, pebbles, balloons, metal designs, ornaments, decorative/decorated trees, glass, pottery, jars or containers, wood or metal cases, banners, knickknacks, solar power lights, etc.
5. All flowers and decorations will be removed by the cemetery personnel one (1) week following the holiday.
6. All flowers and decorations must be placed on the headstone and are prohibited on the ground around the headstone.
7. No rocks, sand, seashells, or planters are allowed in front of or around the headstone. They will be removed and discarded.
8. Planting of Flowers, Shrubs or trees are prohibited and will be removed by Cemetery personnel.
9. A vault is required for each grave in the cemetery.
10. No more than two cremains can be buried on one gravesite.
11. No ATV's, golf carts or dirt bikes are permitted in the cemetery.
12. The Cemetery is neither liable nor responsible for any personal injury, loss, or damage (whether the damage is direct or collateral) arising from causes beyond its control, including vandals, the elements, deterioration due to the passage of time, acts of God or thieves.
13. The cemetery has the ultimate right to maintain its grounds in a safe manner.
14. The cemetery board has the right to monitor and regulate each gravesite and carry out decisions in order to maintain the overall aesthetics and standards of the cemetery.

COLUMBARIUM RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Columbarium niches are 12x12x12 inches. It is the responsibility of niche purchaser to provide the proper size cremation container(s).
2. A maximum of 2 cremations per niche.
3. Fresh cut or artificial flowers may be placed on the niche in a tube wall vase decoration holder. The vase must be approved by cemetery personnel. Items placed in violation of this rule will be removed.
4. A veteran's marker can be used on a niche door in place of an engraving.
5. If, in the judgment of the VCA, a decoration is inappropriate or has become deteriorated, unsightly, or faded; it will be removed and disposed of.
